In Forms 4 and 5 pupils have a degree of choice about the subjects they wish to continue to study to IGCSE level. In making this decision the pupils, parents and staff must take into account the following:

- Which subjects are they good at? (Refer to exam results).
- Which subjects are they expected to achieve in? (Refer to target grades).
- Which subjects do they enjoy?
- Which subjects are important for their overall development?
- Which subjects can the school viably offer?

Taking this into account, we have decided that all students will study a core curriculum of compulsory subjects. Pupils then choose from a number of optional subjects, which must include **at least two sciences** (agriculture or biology, chemistry or physics) as well as **ICT or Computer Science**.

Parents are asked to discuss these choices with their child following the **Parent-Teacher Consultations on Saturday 23rd June**. Please indicate your preferences in the spaces below and **return this form by on Wednesday 4th July (after half-term)**. Students may then be individually interviewed to check that they are capable of studying their chosen subjects and that they match with their career aspirations. Students will be advised if their preferred combination of subjects is not possible, and given the opportunity to adjust their preferences accordingly. Parents will be notified of any changes. We hope to complete the process by half-term break of Term 3.
